Random Sample Voting

Basic idea

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- 2 Give them a ballot with a unique set of IDs
- 3 Have them cast their votes online
- 4 Publish results

What is new

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- Strong anonymity
- No vote buying
- Easy to audit
- Very limited hacking possibilities (through audits)
- For a fraction of current costs

Anonymity

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- Voters can't prove who they voted for

Anonymity

Three guarantees:

- No one can find who voters are
- Voters can't prove who they voted for
- Voters can't prove they are voters

Verifiability

Everyone can audit the different steps to make sure that:

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- The votes cast were well recorded

Verifiability

Everyone can audit the different steps to make sure that:

- The choice of voters was random
- The votes cast were well recorded
- The tally is correct

- Ensured voting access

Effective

- Easy to use, low cost

- Possibility of re-running if too close
